Students must attend a four-year undergraduate accredited college or university in Indiana and must have a minimum grade average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

All applicants must be U.S. Citizens

Students may be male or female

The deadline for applications is February 1, 2023

Each applicant must choose a Scholarship Essay Topic (see Scholarship Essay Topic file) and submit a separate essay with each scholarship application

- **Must be registered to vote.**
- **Applicants must be a Junior or Senior in the fall of 2023**

Vice Presidents General Scholarship applicants:

- **Applicants must be permanent residents of any of the following counties:**
Marion, Boone, Hamilton, Hancock, Shelby, Johnson, Morgan, Hendricks
- **Must be registered to vote.**
- **Applicants must be a Sophomore, Junior, or Senior in the fall of 2023**
